Food Hygiene and Safety Skills, Barista Training

Dear Parent/Carer,

Students in Years 9 to 11 are invited to participate in this practical course which is designed to give your child the necessary skills and knowledge required to extract and serve espresso coffee beverages using commercial espresso machines and grinders. This course applies to any hospitality organization that serve espresso coffee beverages and espresso machine operators who operate with some level of independence and under limited supervision. This will assist in future employment within the hospitality industry.
