Visual Arts and Design Specialist Stream Application Year 7 2025

Dulwich High School of Visual Arts and Design provides opportunities for students to pursue excellence within the disciplines of Visual Arts and Design, whilst studying a comprehensive curriculum prescribed by NESA, for the attainment of ROSA (Record of Student Achievement) and Higher School Certificate.

Students seeking admission to the Visual Arts and Design Specialist stream need to demonstrate a strong engagement and commitment as creative students. The application, interview and portfolio process provide students with the opportunity to showcase their level of creative thinking, problem solving and artmaking skills.

Students will be considered for a place in the Visual Arts and Design Specialist Stream at Dulwich High School of Visual Arts and Design by a panel on all three components of the application process. The 3 components are:

1. Application

The completed application provides information on student interests and academic capacity relevant for demonstrating suitability for the Visual Arts and Design Specialist Stream.

The application must be completed in full. Incomplete forms will not be processed. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure all sections are completed and submitted by the due date.

2. Interview

Applicants will be interviewed regarding their portfolio (4-6 items), their general ability, interests and experiences of art and/or design including, making practices, thinking processes, and appreciation.

All applicants will be notified by email of the interview date and time. See Application Schedule below. If you do not receive a notification of an interview date, please contact Ms Kardum on 9560 7299 on Tuesday 30 April 2024.

3. Portfolio

Applicants will present a portfolio representing their body of work during **the interview**. This requires 4 to 6 original pieces of the applicant's artwork and/or design projects demonstrating experiences using a variety of mediums. The works presented must have been produced within the last 18 months and must be **entirely** the student's own work. Work samples may include painting, drawing, video or animation, sculpture, textiles design, photography or graphic, jewellery or timber design.

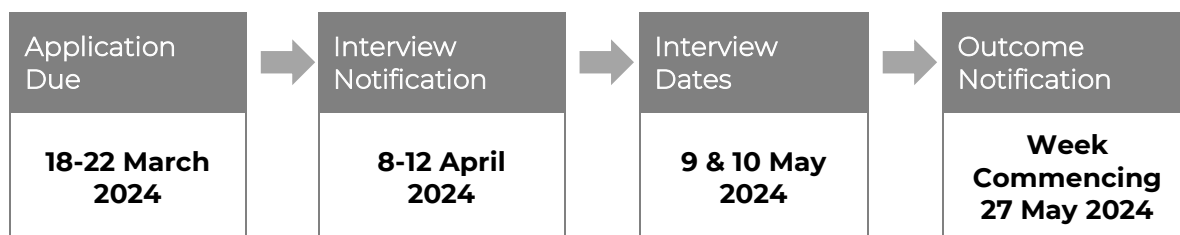
