- Certificates from workshops/courses outside of school
- Evidence of involvement (for example: choir, band, debating, SRC, Sport, community)
- NAPLAN report
- Semester 1 & 2 school reports - *All reports and NAPLAN to be certified as true copies of the originals by the current school (with the school stamp)*

Section D: Academic Information This form must be completed and submitted by the applicant's Primary School (Principal or delegated staff member).

Section E: Background Information This form must be completed and submitted by the applicant's Primary School (Principal or delegated staff member).

Expression of Interest form (EOI): Your child's **Expression of Interest form** (EOI) must be submitted online through your Primary Schools website.

Applicants will be notified of the interview (if required) by email in Term 2, 2025

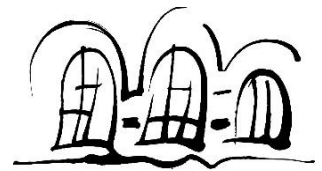
